The latest release of Quest ActiveRoles Direct extends the capabilities of the product to include support for Microsoft Exchange Server 2007 and Microsoft Windows Server 2008.

## **Support for Windows Server 2008**

ActiveRoles Direct can now be installed and used on a computer running a 32-bit or a 64-bit version of Windows Server 2008.
