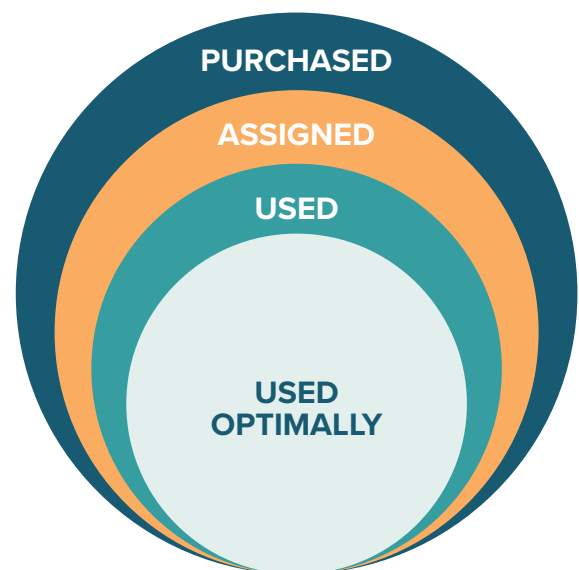

- Administrative access to Azure AD
